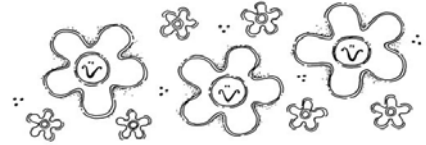

Date	Class	Focus Area	Description
March 18	Infants	Child Growth and Development	Part 1 in the three-part child development series. This class will explore all the areas of development dealing with children from conception to 18 months.
April 1	Outdoor Safety	Safe and Healthy Environment	With summer approaching your kids will want to be outside more often. This class will cover the importance of outdoor safety and ideas to improve your playground areas.

CAR SEAT CHECKS

The Bear River Health Department offers a clinic for parents/caregivers to learn how to properly install their child safety seat. Certified car seat technicians will educate parents on proper installation, check for recalls, and answer any questions during the visit. New car seats are not available during these clinics. KIDS FIRST

WHAT: Kids First is a child passenger safety education class that teaches parents/caregivers how to properly install child safety seats. The 2-hour class includes: lectures, discussions, videos, and hands-on practice sessions. The class is facilitated by a certified car seat technician.

WHEN: Held every other month starting in January.

COST: \$35 fee includes a car seat and class materials.

WHERE: Class is held at the Bear River Health Department, 655 E. 1300 N., Logan, UT 84341

WHY: Nationally 4 out of 5 car seats are installed improperly. Locally, motor vehicles crashes are a leading cause of death for children 1-14.
